## Inviting the Salmon Home

hum and coho salmon and cutthroat trout have lived in the creek for 6000 years – until 20th century urban changes. The Friends of Bowker Creek are working to bring salmon back. Will you join us in the effort? We are using citizen science methods to restore favourable conditions, in cooperation with community and institutional partners and all levels of government. We employ Department of Fisheries and Oceans "Streamkeepers" protocols and many volunteer hours in assessment and habitat restoration, as we move forward our application for Chum salmon eggs to incubate in the stream. Our hope is for adult salmon returning in 3-5 years.

The FoBC Society also has board membership in the Peninsula Streams Society and is a member of the Pacific Streamkeepers Federation.
